

Valor Math Placement Tests

Valor Math Placement Tests are designed for freshman students that would like to enroll in any math course above Algebra I **OR** any freshman student that scored below a 70% on the online Math Diagnostic Exam.

Testing Dates:

May 1st 9:00-11:00 AM

May 5th 4:00-7:00 PM

The format of each test is 50 multiple choice questions and will take approximately 60 minutes. Answers will be graded strictly as a percentage correct out of 50 questions. A minimum passing score for all three tests is a 70%. A scientific calculator is helpful for all three tests but is only necessary. Graphing calculators are not allowed. **There is no need to sign up ahead of time. Students should just come during one of the available times with a pencil and a calculator.**

Pre-Algebra

This test is for students who have had Pre-Algebra in 8th grade or students that have had some exposure to Algebra I but have not completed a full year. **Passing this test is mandatory for all students wishing to take Honors Algebra I.** If a student passes this test, determination of Honors Algebra I will be based upon a combination of the test score, the initial entrance exam test score, teacher recommendation, and previous math course grades.

Algebra I

This test is for students that who have had a full year of Algebra in 8th grade. **Passing this test is mandatory for all students wishing to take Geometry or Honors Geometry.** If a student passes this test, final determination of Geometry or Honors Geometry will be based upon a combination of this test score, the initial entrance exam test score, teacher recommendation, and previous math course grades.

Geometry

This test is designed for students that have completed both Algebra I and Geometry. **Passing this test is mandatory for all students wishing to take Algebra 2/Trigonometry or Honors Algebra 2/Trigonometry.** If a student passes this test, final determination between Algebra 2/Trigonometry and Honors Algebra 2/Trigonometry will be based on the combination of this test score, the initial entrance exam score, teacher recommendation, and previous math course grades.

Algebra II/Trigonometry

Any freshman wishing to take a course above Algebra II/Trigonometry must get the approval of the Math Department Chair. Determination will be made based upon teacher recommendation, previous math course grades, and an additional test may be required.
