

SAT Test Prep (English and/or Math) – Fall 2010

SAT review is a test of your already acquired knowledge and skills, but preparing for it should include more than just reviewing what you already know. Not only should you review these skills, but you also should learn to apply them in a new light. You need to relate your knowledge to the format of SAT. That means you should know the pattern, types of questions, number of questions, marks awarded to them etc., and you should also be able to use your knowledge to understand and answer the questions asked in SAT.

This SAT Test Prep course will familiarize students with the format of the SAT, and teach testing techniques and strategies. It is through SAT prep reviews that you can reinforce your knowledge required to take the test and do well. Most high school students have already been introduced to the majority of concepts tested on the SAT. However our guidance will assist students in applying their high school knowledge to the standardized test format. Classes will focus on developing test-taking strategies while also reinforcing concepts in mathematics, critical reading and writing. In addition, the course offers students frequent opportunities to practice in test conditions. Students can sign up for English or Math individually or both prep classes together.

SAT dates for 2010: Oct. 9th, Nov. 6, Dec. 4. Any student who takes this SAT Test Prep class is eligible for free tune-up classes in the fall, offered before the listed testing dates.
