### Plan 1:

Be **thoroughly** familiar with the content and practice problems of sections P.1-P.3 as well as 1.1-1.5 in the AP Calculus book. This material is extremely condensed and should be carefully read and practiced. We will not cover chapter P, but will briefly cover chapter 1. When the course starts in August, you should have mastered chapter P and be very strong with chapter 1 material.

### Plan 2:

Be thoroughly familiar with the content and practice problems out of your Pre-Calculus text book from the following sections:

2.1-2.2; 2.5-2.6

3.1-3.3
